Special Shindig - 30 year Anniversary

SPURS Therapeutic Riding Center was founded in the Spring of 1992 and is currently one of the largest and oldest riding centers in the state of South Dakota. The idea to form a non-profit origination dedicated to improving the lives of people with disabilities was developed by a group of community-minded individuals including Pat and Jim Bishop (horse owners), Vi Stoia, Jeff Sveen, and Jack Thompson, all of whom were instrumental in helping to make SPURS the phenomenal program it is today. After countless hours of volunteer work the Bishop's farm was transformed into a



therapeutic riding center and received accreditation thought the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International (PATH); the accreditation organization for therapeutic riding programs across the country. Pat recognized the seriousness and professionalism required to work with horses, kids, and people with disabilities so she later became a certified instructor through PATH.

Early on plans were put in place to develop a program that would include a modern riding facility dedicated to therapeutic riding and instructional training, riding barn with stalls, an indoor and outdoor arena, and meeting and physical therapy facility. Initially funding was provided by the founding members themselves in addition to funds received from numerous grants and fundraising efforts. When the program started it only had a handful of riders, a few horses, and a dozen volunteers but the success of the program quickly drew the attention of local schools, universities, and organizations from across South Dakota. In 1997, SPURS moved to its permanent location at 1006 130th Street with a 40-acre facility which has become one of the elite therapeutic riding centers in the region with 8 Staff members, 54 Riders (200+ before the Covid 19 pandemic took over the world), 16 Horses, and 35 wonderful volunteers.

Next year will be the 30th Anniversary of the formation of SPURS so several special activities will be planned throughout the year.


Upward Bound


